Content of the new CME e-learning course

He describes the essential steps to diagnose and treat septic shock using the example of a patient with liver cirrhosis. Advanced hemodynamic monitoring is essential in septic shock to clarify the therapeutic decisions and improve the outcome of the patient.

Excellent author and speaker

For nearly fifteen years, Prof. Dr. Wolfgang Huber is leading the intensive care unit of the *rechts der Isar* hospital. He is part of the medical advisory board of PULSION and one of the key opinion leaders for hemodynamic monitoring. With his research he is focusing on the hemodynamic in pancreatitis, liver cirrhosis, sepsis and ARDS.
